As Market Place is the main central road through the Town it is unlikely it would become a clean air zone unless, of course, it was completely pedestrianised. However, there are currently no plans to do this.	
The survey of the Market Place was undertaken by North Norfolk District Council and Norfolk County Council and you should contact them for this information. We do not hold details here.	
You mentioned setting up a Resident's Group, but you were not specific as to what the group would be concerned with. May be you could provide some information.	
North Norfolk District Council are reviewing the Market Place situation on a regular basis so there will be no voting involved for residents. However, if you feel strongly about this in any way you could always write to the District Council about your concerns.	
With the continuing COVID-19 restrictions that are being imposed and government guidance regularly changing, no one can predict how North Norfolk District Council will deal with the free parking concession in the future.
